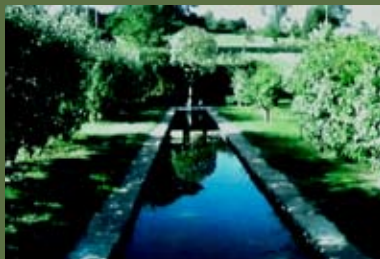
# OPEN GARDEN

Within 5 minutes walk there is a hanging valley set in woodland, an ideal place for a 'bring your own' picnic lunch. Very popular last year.
